

Begin: Read Revelation 21-22:5

1. **Understanding the Future**: Revelation 21:1-2 describes a "new heaven and a new earth." What does this passage reveal about the nature of God's future creation? How does knowing this future impact your life today?

2. **The Significance of God's Presence**: Revelation 21:3 emphasizes that God will dwell among His people. What does it mean for God to dwell with us in this new creation? How does this shape your understanding of God's relationship with His people?

3. **Elimination of Sorrow**: In Revelation 21:4, it says, "He will wipe every tear from their eyes." What sources of sorrow and pain do you long for God to eliminate in your life and in the world? How does this promise of no more death or pain encourage you?

4. **The Water of Life**: Revelation 21:6 mentions the "spring of the water of life." What does this water symbolize, and how can we experience this life now? What steps can you take to "drink" from this water more deeply in your daily walk with God?

5. **Diversity in the Kingdom**: Revelation 21:24 speaks of the "nations" (ethne) bringing their glory into the New Jerusalem. What does this teach us about the diversity of God's kingdom? How should this vision of diversity influence how we live and relate to others today?

6. **The Tree of Life**: Revelation 22:2 describes the tree of life, bearing fruit every month and healing the nations. How does this imagery connect to the story of Eden, and what does it signify about God's plan for humanity?

7. **Serving in Eternity**: Revelation 22:3-5 describes the servants of God serving Him and reigning forever. What might it look like to serve God in eternity? How does this future role influence your current service and calling in the church and world?
